2018-2019 Work Plan – Prioritization and Finalization

5.1 Staff suggested that timelines and priorities be determined for the 2018-2019 Work Plan items identified at the September meeting. The Committee considered postponing certain items, and added additional items for inclusion. The Committee agreed to the following prioritization and tentative schedule of Work Plan items:

- November: explore the adequacy of the TransLink bus service in Port Moody, specifically the bus services operational from local schools. The Committee could propose the introduction of additional bus services during peak times by partnering with local school councils;
- January: explore affordable and robotic ways to dispose of all types of garbage in a singular bin. The City could potentially promote this affordable recycling opportunity to other municipalities;
- February-April: promote City projects that have a low environmental impact such as switching street lights to LED lighting and advocating the banning/restricting of plastic straws or introducing a plastic straw free week as Earth Day initiatives; and
- March: host an event to raise awareness of youth mental health possibly through local schools and their student leadership councils, and support existing mental health initiatives during Youth Mental Health Week.

The Committee agreed to add the following recurring items to the 2018-2019 Work Plan:

- hold a Youth Focus Committee meeting in Council Chambers;
- nominate recipients for the Youth Scholarship award; and
- organise the Seniors Pancake Breakfast.

The Committee agreed to postpone the following items identified at the September Committee meeting:

- drafting and promoting of the provincial Education Reform Bill;
- hosting a TED Talk event and joining the TEDxYouth@LafargeLake event; and
- hosting a job planning session and a job fair.

Actions: Staff to undertake the following actions to support the identified 2018-2019 Work Plan items:

- schedule a presentation from the Parks Division on providing an update on Bert Flinn Park;
- investigate the status of the metal storage bin located behind the Carpentry Shop in Rocky Point Park, if the bin

- requires repainting, and whether the Cultural Services Division will partner with the Committee on this initiative;
- invite Daniel Josok, the Volunteer Coordinator, to present on volunteer opportunities for City events; and
 - obtain information from the Communications Division on ways to promote youth focus events and initiatives on social media, possibly through a youth focused Instagram account.

Staff noted that the 2018-2019 Work Plan, including associated costs, would be presented for adoption at the next Committee meeting.
