Results at a glance

98%



of residents rate their quality of life as "very good" or "good"

92%



want access to City services and information, mostly online or a combination of online and in-person

55% say quality of life has stayed the same and 12% say it has improved. Top three reasons why quality of life has improved:

1. Growth/development
2. Good amenities/services
3. More activities/things to do



Social issues like affordable housing are a growing concern

94%

are "very satisfied" or "somewhat satisfied" with the level and quality of City services

32% say quality of life has worsened. Top three reasons why quality of life has worsened:

1. Traffic
2. Growth/development
3. More expensive/cost of living



61% are 'very' or 'somewhat satisfied' with the City's municipal government, including Council and Administration as a whole

(79% are satisfied with Administration, excluding Council, and 52% are satisfied with Council, excluding Administration)

Residents say the most important local issues facing Port Moody are transportation (38%) and growth and development (36%)



Recreation (14%) and traffic (13%) top the list of desired service improvements



83% think they receive good value for their tax dollars



52% of residents would rather pay increased taxes than see existing services cut
