I waive any claim I may have with respect to any loss or damage to my banner design and/or banner created under this application.

I understand that I authorize the City of Port Moody, for non-commercial and municipal purposes only, the right to use a digital image of my banner design for promotion of its StreetArts Banner Program and Public Art program.

Banner Design Specifications

1. **Originality:** All entries must be your own original design.
2. **Content:** Your design should be an imaginative, original interpretation of the theme, using the design colour palette:
 - light green
 - light blue
 - purple
 - red
 - orange
 - yellow
 - designs may be highlighted or outlined in black or white
 - do not blend colours, use shading techniques or use blank/white space in your design
3. **Submission Format:** Your design must be submitted in colour and must fit into a rectangle, measuring 14.7cm tall, by 8.5cm wide. This format is necessary to project your design onto a street banner. If your design is chosen, we will enlarge and outline your design on the street banner prior to your painting session. Your design should be considered finished artwork and coloured in the manner you intend to paint the banner. Simple designs using bold, solid colours are the most effective.
4. **Submission Details:** Your name, address, and phone number must be written on the back of the design template. Completed entry forms and design template will be accepted at Port Moody City Hall at either the reception desk or at Cultural Services Department. Design submissions become the property of the City of Port Moody.

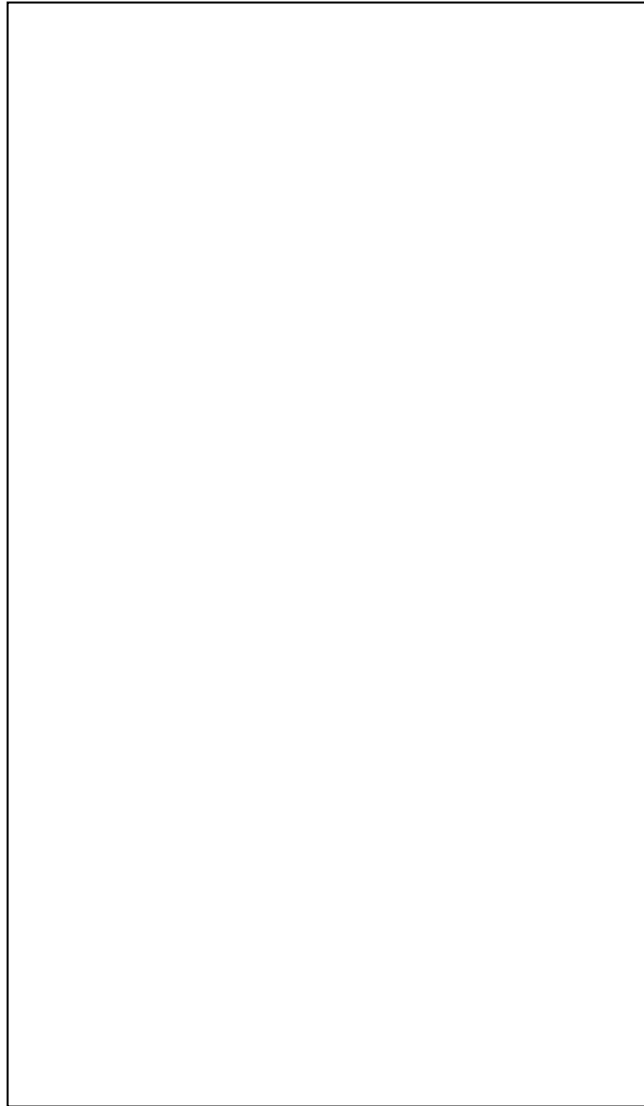
