

City of Port Moody 2022 General Local Election

Notice of Nomination

PORT MOODY VOTES

The City of Port Moody is notifying electors that our Chief Election Officer will receive nominations for the offices of Mayor (1), Councillor (6) and School Trustee (2) starting at 9am on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 until 4pm on Friday, September 9, 2022. Nominations must be received between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays).

Nomination papers must be filed with the Chief Election Officer at City Hall between 9am on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 and 4pm on Friday, September 9, 2022. Candidates are strongly encouraged to make an appointment with the Chief Election Officer to submit nomination documents. To make an appointment with the Chief Election Officer, email elections@portmoody.ca, call 604.469.4505, or visit the Legislative Services counter on the first floor of Port Moody City Hall, 100 Newport Drive.

A person is qualified to be nominated, to be elected, and to hold office as Mayor, Councillor, or School Trustee if they are:

- 18 years of age or older;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or the *School Act* from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office, or otherwise disqualified by law.

Availability of List of Registered Electors

Beginning Tuesday, August 30, 2022 until the close of general voting for the election on October 15, 2022, a copy of the List of Registered Electors will be available for public inspection at the Legislative Services Division at City Hall. Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not use the information included in the list except for the purposes of Part 3 of the *Local Government Act*. The list is available between 8:30am to 5pm, Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays).

If an elector wishes to have their personal information omitted or obscured from the List of Registered Electors, they must submit a request to the Election Office by 4pm on Tuesday, August 23, 2022.

Objection to Registration of an Elector

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the List of Registered Electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4pm on Thursday, September 9, 2022.

An objection may only be made in writing by a person entitled to be registered as an elector in the City of Port Moody. Objections can only be made on the basis that the person whose name appears has either died or is not qualified to be registered as an elector in the City of Port Moody at the time of the objection.

Campaign Period Expense Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 General Local Election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- Mayor: \$28,561.09
- Councillor: \$14,385.30
- School Trustee: \$14,146.80

Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 General Local Election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- Directed Advertising Expense Limit (Mayor and Councillor): \$1,428.05
- Directed Advertising Expense Limit (School Trustee): \$809.84
- Cumulative Third Party Advertising Limit: \$161,967.47
