Elector Registration

If you are not on the list of registered electors, register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at each voting place.

In order to be eligible to register as a resident elector, you must meet all following qualifications at time of voting:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A resident of B.C. for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- A resident of Port Moody; and
- Not be disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors who need to register at the time of voting must produce two pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) that together prove residency and identity.

In order to be eligible to register as a non-resident property elector, you must meet all following qualifications at time of voting:

- Not be entitled to register as a resident elector of Port Moody;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A resident of B.C. for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- A registered owner of real property in the City of Port Moody for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- Not be disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-resident property electors will be required to complete an application for registration as a non-resident property elector and to provide at the voting place the following information:

- 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity;
- Satisfactory proof (e.g. current title search) that the person is entitled to register in relation to the real property; and
- If applicable, written consent from a majority of the other registered owners of the property.

Get an application for registration as a non-resident property elector from the Chief Election Officer at City Hall, 100 Newport Drive, Port Moody either during regular office hours (8:30am–5pm) prior to 5pm on Friday, October 14, 2022, or from the election official at voting locations for advance and general voting, during voting hours.



Voting by Mail Ballot

Fill out the online Mail Ballot Application Form or pick one up from the Legislative Services counter at City Hall (100 Newport Drive). Valid proof of identification is required when applying for a mail ballot package. Submit completed applications electronically, in-person at the Legislative Services counter at Port Moody City Hall or

mail to the Elections Office at 100 Newport Drive, Port Moody B.C. V3H 5C3. At the time of application, you will be required to select the method of delivery for your mail ballot package, which could be by regular letter mail or in-person pick up (ID required).

Mail your ballot or drop it off at the Legislative Services counter at City Hall. From October 3, 2022

to October 15, 2022 (excluding October 10), the Legislative Services Division will be open from 8am to 8pm for mail ballot pick-up and drop-off.

All mail ballots must be received by the Chief Election Officer (or designate) at City Hall by no later than 8pm on Saturday, October 15, 2022, in order to be counted in the 2022 General Local Election.
