

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CITY HOCKEY PROGRAMS

Safety is the Top Priority

All hockey programs are non-contact

- Behaviors such as engaging in horseplay, pushing, shoving, body checking, etc. are unsafe for all participants. If a child is actively engaging in these behaviors, it will be addressed immediately, and staff will follow up with the child and the parent(s).

Sportsmanship and Respectful Conduct

- Behaviors, actions, or language from the child or the parent(s) that are inappropriate, unsportsmanlike, or disrespectful in nature will not be tolerated. Instructor will address concerns with the child and parent(s) if they arise.

Player Code of Conduct

- Respect the property around me
- Use positive language and behaviors to build each other up
